ABOUT SEDRO-WOOLLEY: After routing Lynden 42-13 in last year's 2A title game, the Cubs return to the semifinals with their Wing-T offense and a ramped-up passing attack. Senior RB Quinn Carpenter leads the multifaceted ground game with 762 yards on 128 carries and 12 TDs. Senior QB Devin Willard has been highly efficient, completing 92 of 138 passes for 1,190 yards and 11 TDs. The Cubs started 2-2 and have gone 7-1 since with the one loss to 3A Ferndale.

ABOUT PROSSER: The Mustangs' defense hasn't allowed a point in the postseason and has eight interceptions in two games. Junior QB Tanner Bolt, who has thrown for 2,659 yards and 38 TDs, completed 21 passes to eight different receivers last Saturday. Senior WR Roy Borrego ranks behind Kason Blair and Javier Diaz in season receptions but he had the breakout game in the quarterfinals with five catches for 108 yards and two TDs. Prosser is 8-4 in the semifinals since 1991.
